Ohio State Immunization Law requires that all school children be adequately immunized against the following diseases: Diphtheria, Pertussis (Whooping Cough), Tetanus, Polio, Rubella (German measles), Rubeola (regular measles), Mumps, Hepatitis B and Chicken Pox.

Immunizations (as required by Ohio State Law R.C. 3313.67, 3323.05, 3313.71 and Board Policy 8.9)

DPT or TD (Adult): Kindergarten: 5 doses of DTaP, DTP, or DT, or any combination, if the fourth dose was administered prior to the 4th birthday; **Grades 1-12:** 3-4 doses of DTaP, DTP, DT or Td or any combination; **Grade 7:** 1 dose of Tdap or Td vaccine must be administered prior to entry.

Polio Vaccine: Kindergarten: 4 doses of any combination of OPV or IPV, the final dose must be administered on or after the 4th birthday regardless of the number of previous doses; **Grades 1-12:** 4 doses if a combination of OPV or IPV was administered. 4 doses of all OPV or all IPV is required if the third dose of either vaccine was administered prior to the 4th birthday.

MMR (Measles/Mumps/Rubella): Kindergarten-Grade 12: 2 doses required. Dose #1 must have been given on or after 1st birthday. Dose #2 must be given at least 28 days after Dose #1.

Hepatitis B: Kindergarten-Grade 11: 3 or more doses required. Doses must be given at proper intervals.

Varicella (Chickenpox): Kindergarten: 2 doses; **Grades 1-4:** 1 dose on or after the first birthday.

Required by Hamilton County:

Tuberculin skin testing is required in accordance with the regulations of the Hamilton County Board of Tuberculosis Control. We need a record of your child having received the immunization and/or tests that are checked below:

If a pupil is transferring into the Forest Hills School District, the school will request health records from the previous school. In the event the previous school does not forward the health record, or it is incomplete, the parents will be notified to complete the health record to comply with the Ohio Revised Code and Forest Hills Board Policy. Within fourteen (14) days these immunization records must be complete and in the principal's office or the pupil may be excluded from school. The TB Skin Test as required by Hamilton County Tuberculosis Control Board should be completed within 90 days of admission to school and is not grounds for exclusion.
