GENERAL INFORMATION

REGISTRATION FOR SUMMER PHYSICAL EDUCATION CLASSES WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED VIA U.S. POSTAL SERVICE on a first come, first served basis. A check or money order made payable to Forest Hills School District must accompany your registration form. Mail as soon as possible, as all classes are subject to limited enrollment. Priority will be given to Forest Hills School District residents who register by deadlines below:

7th and 8th Grade Classes and Registration deadline: May 27, 2012

Second Semester High School Classes Registration deadline: June 17, 2012

You will be notified **ONLY** if the class you request is filled or cancelled. Students are to report automatically to their class as scheduled if you do not hear from us.

TUITION

The cost will be listed on the registration form with each course offering. There will be no refunds for any reason once classes begin. Checks are to be made payable to Forest Hills School District. In the event that a class is cancelled because of low enrollment, your money will be refunded.

ATTENDANCE

Due to the short duration of summer classes and the daily concentration of classwork, it is imperative that students attend all classes. If parents/guardians do not call, the absence will be unexcused. Any student receiving an unexcused absence is subject to withdrawal from summer school.
