What?

- College courses taken for both high school and college credit.
- Can be taken:
 - At your high school
 - On a college campus
 - Online through an affiliated Ohio college



Who?

“College Ready” students in
grades 7 through 12 who
qualify for admission



When?

- Whenever college courses are offered during the school year and during summer sessions.
 - Day
 - Night
 - Weekend



Where?

- FHSD Delivery Option 1 @ IHE
 - IHE = Institute of Higher Education
- FHSD Delivery Option 2 @ Your High School
 - Honors Pre-Calculus
 - Biology for the Health Professions
 - Engineering Foundations
 - Engineering Models



Why?

- To challenge yourself in college course work and/or in order to take courses that are not available at your high school.
- To earn college credit while still in school.
- No cost for tuition or books to students who pass the course or withdrawal prior to the withdrawal deadline



How?

- Express Interest
- Apply
- Test if Necessary
- Enroll in Course(s)



Submit Paperwork

- Paperwork for Submission this Evening:
 1. Intent to Enroll
 2. Checklist of Responsibilities
 3. Acknowledgement of Application Information
- Submitted paperwork does not obligate you to participate but gives you the option
- State deadline for Intent to Enroll – March 31

Apply

FHSD Delivery Option 1 (at IHE)

- Obtain the application for IHE you are interested in and complete and submit as instructions indicate meeting their deadline
- Transcript
- Counselor Signature
- Test Scores (ACT/SAT)
- Set-up and check IHE E-mail account

FHSD Delivery Option 2 (at HS)

- Check Schoology for necessary paperwork
- Listen to announcements, watch twitter, check schoology - make sure you are meeting all deadlines!
- Talk to your counselor if in doubt
- Math Placement test for Honors Pre-Calculus and Engineering

- GPA Requirements
- ACT/SAT
- Math & Writing Placement Test



Deciding to Participate

1. IHE's have their own withdrawal dates
2. CC+ is for transcribed credit
3. The state of Ohio guarantees transferability of CC+ credits to all Ohio public IHE's. Depending on major or degree requirements, courses may only transfer as elective credit.
4. Athletic eligibility & scheduling for extracurricular activities
5. Transportation and parking costs are your responsibility.



Potential Risks

- Be aware that procedures & classroom expectations could be very different from your FHSD school
- College grading scales may be different from FHSD. The grade reported from the college will be what appears on your transcript.
- Calendar years can be different. All final grades must be reported to your high school before graduation in order to participate in the ceremony. Also, school breaks may not line up, and if you are taking courses through both schools, you may not get to take a school break.
- Transferability does not equal applicability





**CC+ Courses must:
be non-religious,
& be non-remedial**



Credit Limits

- Limits
30 semester credit hours per school year (includes summer school)
- Not more than 120 semester hour credits in middle & high school combined



Credit Equivalence

Three or more CC+
semester hour credits
=
1 High School
Carnegie unit



Total Credit Limits by Year

- Determine # of high school credits taking (Carnegie units)
- Multiply that number by 3
- Subtract result from 30
- = total # of CC+ semester credit hours in a single school year





Example:

5 HS Carnegie units
 $\times 3 = 15$

Result:

No more than 15 CC+
credits allowed



Advanced Standing Given to CC+ Courses


- In many CC+ courses, students who earn a C or better receive a GPA add-on. Please see your counselor for details.
- GPA add-on weight will be equal to the greatest add-on weight given in the FHSD content department.
