ACADEMICS

College Credit Plus/Dual Credit Courses

Through agreement with neighboring universities, courses are offered for both high school and college credit, and may be taken at the high school campus, university campus or through online opportunities.

Credit is awarded at the end of each semester per school year.

Prior to the 18-19 school year, Honors courses received a .0125 add on weight and Advanced Placement courses received .025 add on weight each semester for grades of C or better.

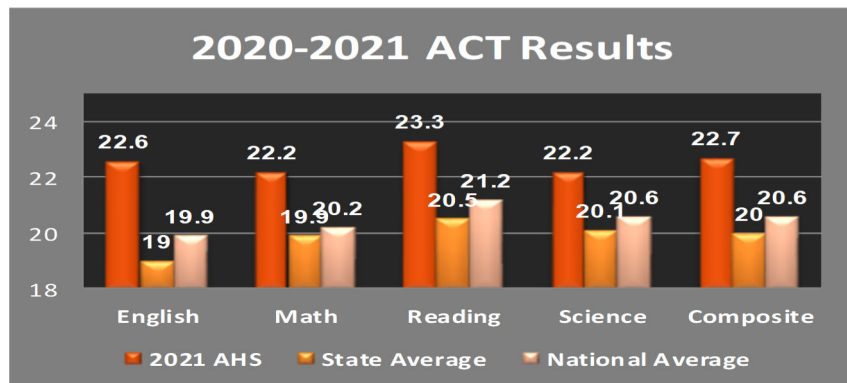
Beginning with the 18-19 school year, Honors courses receive an additional .5 quality point. Advanced Placement courses receive an additional 1.0 quality point.

College Credit Plus courses receive weight that is consistent with Honors and Advanced Placement courses.

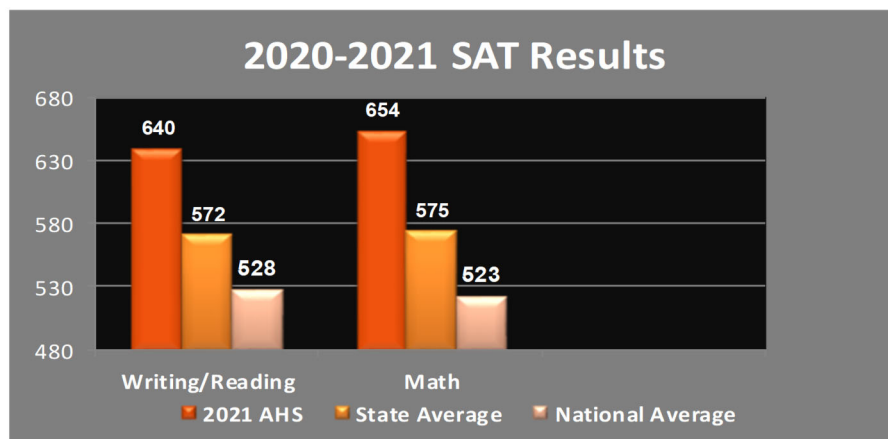
