And, I want to thank you for your recent patience and future support as we work together to navigate this uncharted territory. As always, Forest Hills School District aims to provide all students with high-quality learning opportunities and the resources needed to succeed. This has not and will never change; however, the way we will accomplish this will look and feel different during the upcoming weeks.

As a reminder, all Forest Hills buildings will be closed to students and visitors through Monday, April 13. We are following updates from Governor DeWine regarding further guidance and protocols, and we will continue to communicate updates with you as this situation develops. We must all work together as a community to help slow the spread of coronavirus.

Teachers, principals and staff members district-wide have prepared a comprehensive remote learning plan to continue to engage students across all grade levels. **This plan will go into effect Monday, March 23 - Friday, April 3.**

I want to share more information with you regarding what the next three weeks will look like and what you can expect. Please take a moment to review the district's remote learning plan [FAQ](#) for more information.

**Week #1:** (March 16-March 20)

Teachers will finalize their plans and prepare to effectively deliver remote learning.

**Week #2:** (March 23-March 27)

Teachers will work with students remotely to review, extend and reinforce standards and concepts that students are already familiar with. Teachers will provide feedback to students, analyze student engagement and participation, and make adjustments moving forward.

**Week #3:** (March 30 - April 3)

Teachers will implement new concepts through remote learning opportunities for students based on learning standards. Teachers will communicate clear expectations to students and provide feedback on assignments.

**Spring Break:** (April 6 - April 13)

Students will not be expected to complete schoolwork during this time.
