## ELEMENTARY SUMMER SCHOOL IS NOW ENROLLING



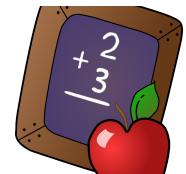
**DATES:** June 6 - July 1, 2022; Monday-Friday

# K-6 ELEMENTARY SUMMER SCHOOL COURSE OPTIONS

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## Kindergarten Skills (Reading, Writing, Math)

This course is designed for students who completed kindergarten in 2021-2022. The class will provide additional practice in reading, writing and math and will focus on language development through daily activities with books, writing and drawing. This class will be offered at two times; students attend **one** time frame.

**TIME: 9:00 a.m.-10:15 a.m. OR 10:30 a.m.-11:45 a.m.**

## Reading/Writing Intervention

This course is designed to provide students additional practice with grade level skills. Students will strengthen and reinforce their reading and writing skills by engaging in a variety of literacy activities to develop reading, vocabulary, comprehension and writing from their current grade level (2021-2022).

**TIME: 9:00 a.m.-10:15 a.m.**

## Math Intervention

This course is designed to provide students additional practice with grade level skills. Students will strengthen and reinforce their math skills by engaging in a variety of math activities and games to develop concept building, problem-solving and overall math skills from their current grade level (2021-2022).

**TIME: 10:30 a.m.-11:45 a.m.**

## Reading/Writing Enrichment

This course is designed to support students working above grade level during the academic year. Students will strengthen their reading and writing skills by engaging in a variety of literacy activities to develop higher level thinking in reading, vocabulary, comprehension and writing.

**TIME: 9:00 a.m.-10:15 a.m.**

## Math Enrichment

This course is designed to support students working above grade level during the academic year. Students will strengthen their math skills through higher level thinking with concept building activities, problem-solving and motivating math games.

**TIME: 10:30 a.m.-11:45 a.m.**
