HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL COURSE OPTIONS

Introduction to Physical Education

Students will participate in a variety of individual, team and lifelong sports, as well as learn physical fitness activities. Students will engage in physical activities that promote skill enhancement, teamwork, sportsmanship, goal setting and life-long enjoyment.

NOTE: This course meets half of the Physical Education requirement. Students may not repeat this course in the second session to meet the PE elective requirement.

Personal Finance

Students will discover new ways to maximize their earning potential, develop strategies for managing resources, explore skills for the wise use of credit, and gain insight into investing money. This course fulfills the financial literacy graduation requirement.

World Cultures

Students will examine cultures of the world from the ancient world to the modern day while exploring the influences of religion, economics, conflict, and political structures.

Credit Recovery

The following credit recovery courses will be offered: Math I, Math II, Math III, Math Foundations, Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry, Biology, Physical Science, English 9-12, Modern World History, U.S. History, American Government and World Cultures.

ACT and SAT Prep Courses; State Testing

The following prep courses will be offered to residents of FHSD and are designed to help students become familiar with test questions. Enrollment is limited.
