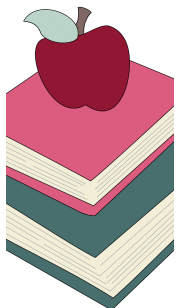
MIDDLE SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL IS NOW ENROLLING

Grade 8 Math Skills

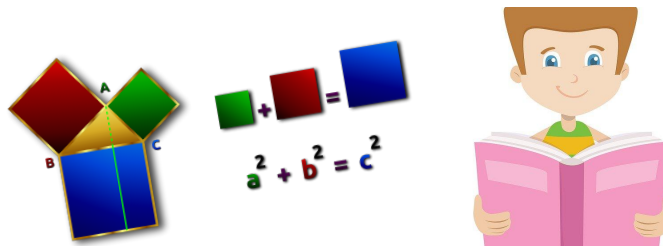
This class is a remedial program designed to provide individualized instruction in math to students in grade 8.
