## SCHOOL

Turpin High School has a student enrollment of approximately 1100 students. The school was recently recognized by US News & World Report as the #11 High School in Ohio (of nearly 900), and # 103 in the United States for STEM education. In 2016, Turpin was one of only 30 high schools in Ohio awarded the State Board of Education's "All A Award," having received a grade of "A" on each aspect of school performance measured on the Ohio School Report Card.

## SCHOOL YEAR

Turpin High School operates on a two-semester system; credit is awarded at the end of each semester. Class periods for 250 minutes per week, 36 weeks per year.

## SECTIONED COURSES

Ability grouping is used in English, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies courses. Students are selected for Honors and Advanced Placement courses by considering teacher recommendation, test results, and past academic record.

## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

A total of 22 units (150 seat-hours per unit) is the minimum requirement for graduation, including:

English	4.0 units
Mathematics	4.0 units
Science	3.0 units
Social Studies	3.5 units
Health	0.5 unit
Physical Education	0.5 unit
Financial Literacy	0.5 unit

## GRADING SCALE, GPA, AND CLASS RANK

A traditional 10 point grading scale, with +/- letter grades is utilized in assigning 0.0 through 4.0 quality points. Rank in class is based upon cumulative grade point average and reflects all members of the class and all grades earned.

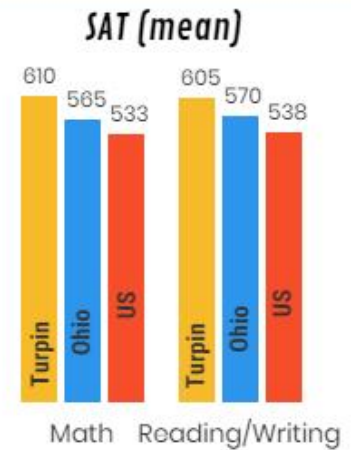
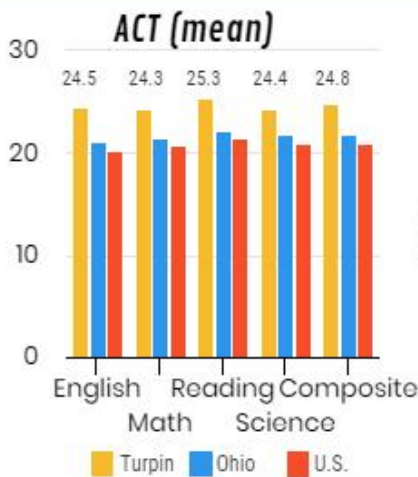

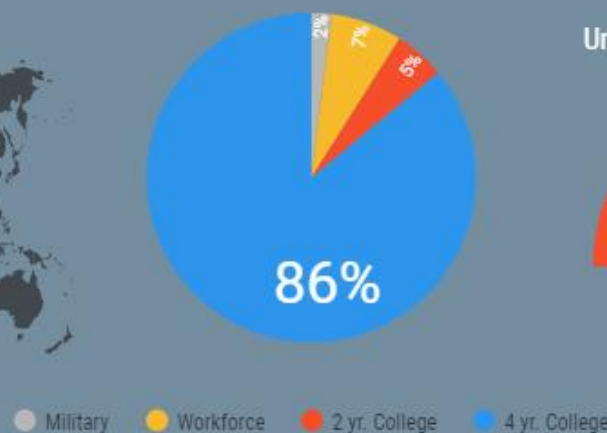
