Career Exploration and Pre-Apprenticeship Event

AHS will be hosting an expanded career exploration event in conjunction with our existing STEM Pre-Apprenticeship program that select juniors and seniors began participating in during the fall semester. ALL JUNIORS will be attending a special event during the school day on 1/29 that will allow everyone an opportunity to learn about a wide variety of industries and career opportunities that are available to students after high school and college.
