SCHOOL FEES

Course fees and general fees are posted to Payschools Central and payment is now due. Please log on to Payschools Central to view your student's fees and make payment. The preferred method of payment would be by credit card on Payschools Central.

Payments may also be made by cash (exact change please), check, or money order made payable to Anderson High School, 7560 Forest Road, Cincinnati, OH 45255, Attention: Eileen Birk. Explanation of Fees

All Anderson High School students are charged school fees which include:

- General fees printing, postage and other general expenses
- Course fees- for workbooks, print materials, lab materials and other classroom supplies
- Testing Fees including PSAT, Pre-ACT, ACT and AP Exam Fees

All fees must be paid prior to the end of the school year. If you have been charged AP Exam fees, these must be paid by April 1, 2023, so that we may order the correct number of tests. Final report cards, diplomas and transcripts will be held until all financial obligations are met. Notice: FHSD will waive fees for persons who are unable to afford them in accordance with its policy. • Scheduling for the 2023-2024 school year

Course requests for next school year are in and we will begin looking at the number of requests for each course and determining schedule and staffing needs. Around mid-March, we will be mailing home a list of each student's course requests for you to verify. Students and parents will have until May 1st to adjust those course requests for next year, by contacting their student's counselor.

• AHS Counseling Information - Spring 2023

The Counseling Department has created a <u>one-stop location</u> with important dates and information for this semester. • Upcoming End of Course Exams and Schedules

Students enrolled in the following classes will be testing first thing each morning for End of Course Exams:

- 04/12 04/13 ELA2
- 04/18 04/19 Algebra 1 and Geometry
- 04/20 US History, American Government, and Biology

These assessments are extremely important and tied to student graduation. Please talk to your child about which classes they are enrolled in and the dates they will be testing.

Due to testing we will run on a two-hour delay for the dates mentioned above. IF YOUR STUDENT IS TESTING, THEY NEED TO BE HERE AT 8AM! Other students who should report at 8am are those attending an AP review session (AP teachers will let students know) as well as students with multiple missing assignments (look for an email or phone call from the school). Transportation will remain as normal on these dates. If your child does not need to report until 10am, but still needs district bussing, they should take their typical scheduled bus and spend the first two hours of the day in the cafeteria with adult supervision. This time will be used as an extended study hall.

• ACADEMIC SUPPORT:

Students have a 25 minute advisory period everyday in their schedule. We encourage students to work with teachers during this time if they need help in any classes. Additionally, teachers have regular office hours before school (7:10-7:55) a few days a week to provide assistance to students.
