College Credit Plus Advising Meetings & Student Communication Responsibilities

Local universities have assured us that, as long as students are proactive in scheduling their CCP advising meetings with their college advisor, there is ample available meeting time outside of the school day. We strongly encourage students to schedule those meetings in after-school hours. We are not able to accommodate virtual student CCP advising meetings during the school day. If students must schedule an advising meeting during school hours, they will need to be signed out of school and then return after the meeting, just as they would for any other appointment.

Students taking CCP classes outside of AHS should remain in contact with their AHS school counselor about the CCP courses they are considering (and selecting) so that we can properly advise them on graduation requirements and accurately update their AHS course requests.
