#### **AP TESTING INFO**

Before long, students will have access to testing locations, seat numbers, and proctors via Schoology. Please pay close attention to the set <u>AP testing schedule</u>. CollegeBoard only allows testing to take place during determined test windows. Therefore, it is important students are where they need to be on time, if not early! 
