# **AP TESTING INFO**

Before long, students will have access to testing locations, seat numbers, and proctors via Schoology. Please pay close attention to the set <u>AP testing schedule</u>. CollegeBoard only allows testing to take place during determined test windows. Therefore, it is important students are where they need to be on time, if not early! Also note, some tests may go past the 2:40 end of day at Anderson High School. No student will be dismissed until the end of the time frame required by CollegeBoard. If your student has any questions about AP testing, tell them to reach out to their AP teacher or Mr.Amburgey.
