AP TESTING INFO

Students have access to testing locations, seat numbers, and proctors via Schoology. Please pay close attention to the set <u>AP testing schedule</u>. CollegeBoard only allows testing to take place during determined test windows. Therefore, it is important students are where they need to be on time, if not early! Also note, some tests may go past the 2:40 end of day at Anderson High School. No student will be dismissed until the end of the time frame required by CollegeBoard. If your student has any questions about AP testing, tell them to reach out to their AP teacher or Mr.Amburgey. All students must test on their school issued device. There are no exceptions. Please make sure your student chargers their device the night before their exam.

Medication Pick Up

All medications that are left over at the end of the school year will need to be picked up by the parent/guardian. No medication will be sent home with a student.

Medication may be picked up from the Health Center through May 30, 2025. Any left over medication that has not been picked up by 2:30 on May 30, 2025 will be disposed of. If you will have a student at Anderson High School next school year and they will require medication during the school day, remember you need a new medicine permission form each school year and each medication requires a separate form. Forms may be found on the Forest Hills School District website under the resource tab.

Immunization Documentation

Attention Parents of rising seniors for the 2025-2026 school year: 12th grade students (including students who attend the Oaks or College Credit Plus programs) are required to have documentation on file in the school health office showing proof of receiving:

• 2 meningitis (mcv4) vaccine doses (Not meningitis B recombinant)

One dose must be administered after the 16th birthday. If the first dose is received after the 16th birthday, only one dose is required. Please provide a current copy of their immunization record to the school health office showing evidence of receiving this vaccine. If you have any questions, please contact the health office. For the safety of all students, the school principal may remove a student from school or establish a deadline for meeting state requirements if the student does not have the necessary immunizations or exemption.

End-of-Year Safety Update from Central Office

In the past few years, the district has noticed an increase in the intensity and duration of the "Water Fights" that have historically taken place during dismissal on the last day of school for students. Some schools had such large activity that it prevented bus routes from dismissing in a timely manner on school property, and there were multiple instances of students being dropped off on their route home and then immediately running into the road to escape family members with water guns.
