END OF 1ST QUARTER

- Freshman thru Juniors will be dismissed at between 11/11:30.
- Lunch will be available for Freshman thru Juniors from 11:00-11:30 if they stay in the building after dismissal. Busing will also be provided at the typical time of day. Students who need to remain on campus will utilize the cafeteria for a study hall.

School Safety Month: Bus Stop Safety

October is School Safety Month in Ohio! This week we want to offer some friendly reminders for bus stop safety. The NHTSA recommends following the SAFE acronym:

- Stay at least 10 feet (or five big steps) away from the curb while waiting.
- Always wait until the bus comes to a stop and the driver says it is OK to board.
- Face forward after sitting down on the bus.
- Exit the bus after it comes to a stop. Cross in front of the bus after looking both ways and the bus driver signals it is okay to cross.
