*Credit is awarded at the end of each semester per school year.*

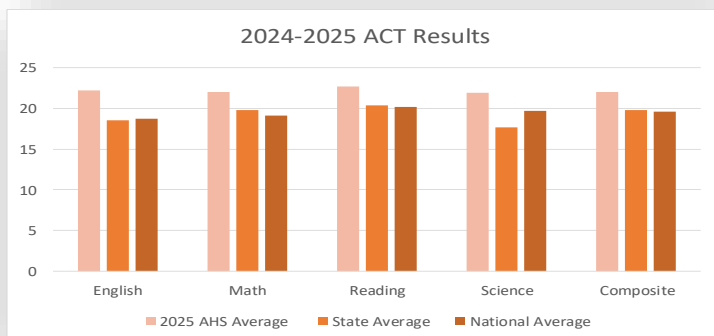
*Honors courses receive an additional .5 quality point. Advanced Placement courses receive an additional 1.0 quality point.*

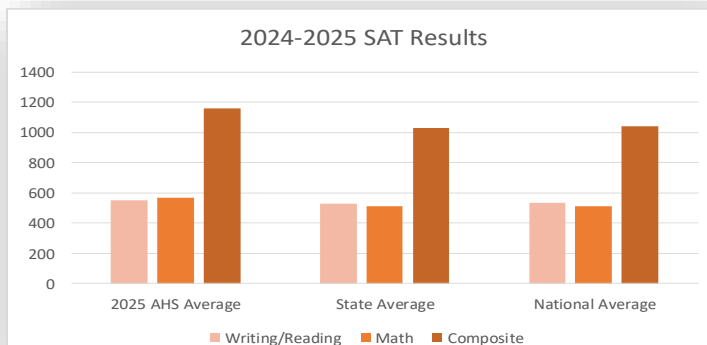
