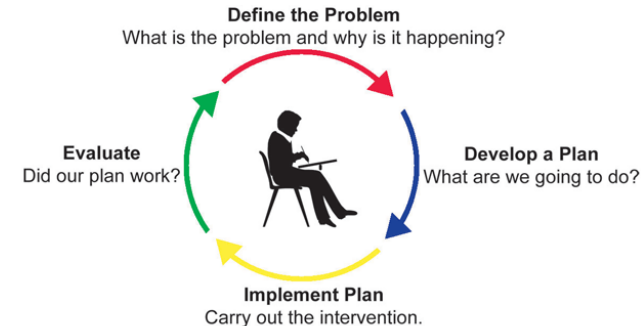

Proactively providing tiers of behavioral and academic support

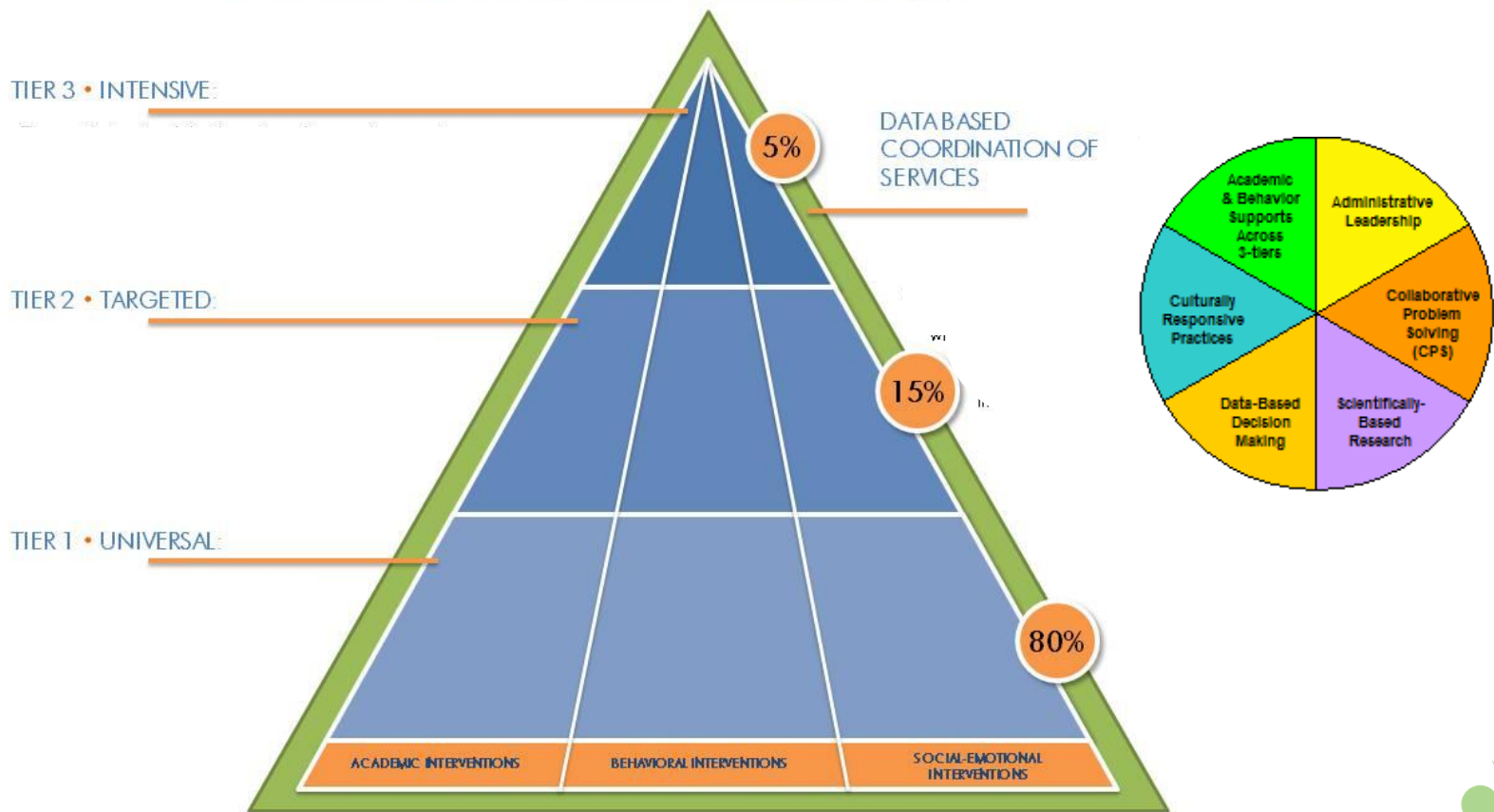
Strong core curriculum

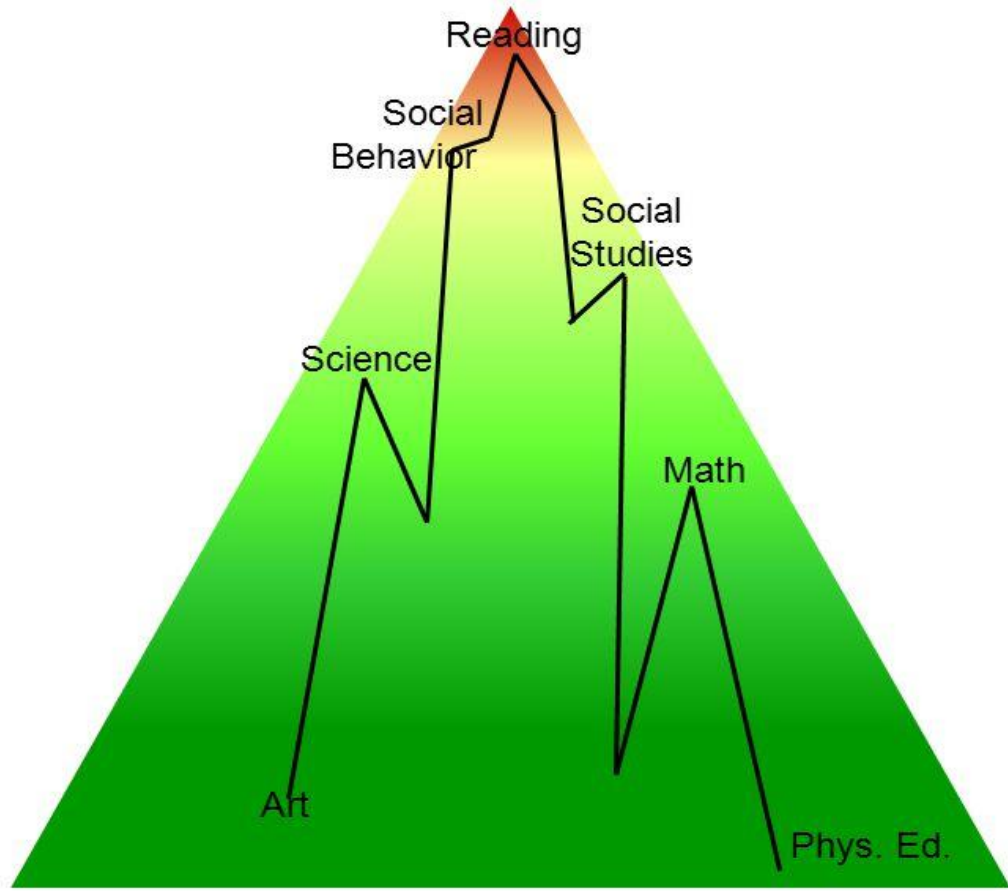
Differentiation

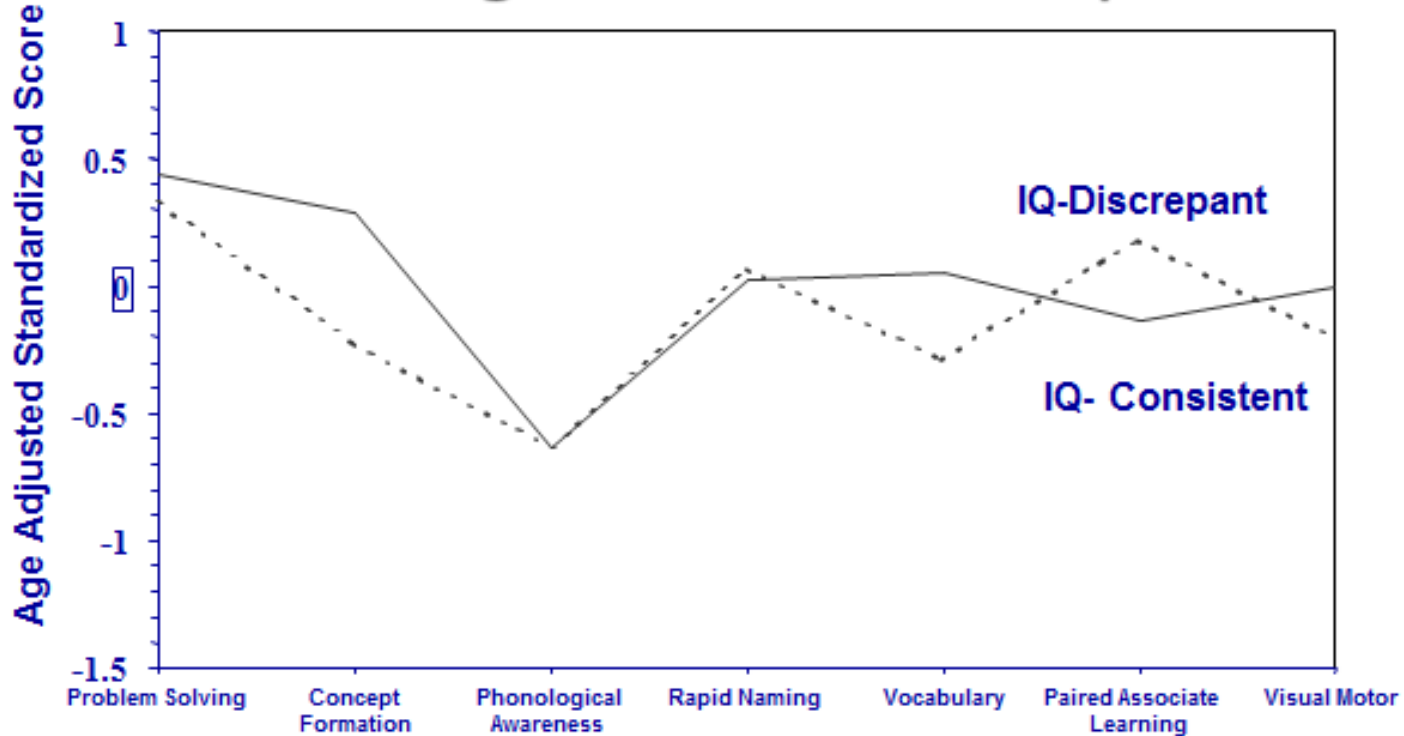
Discrepancy Model

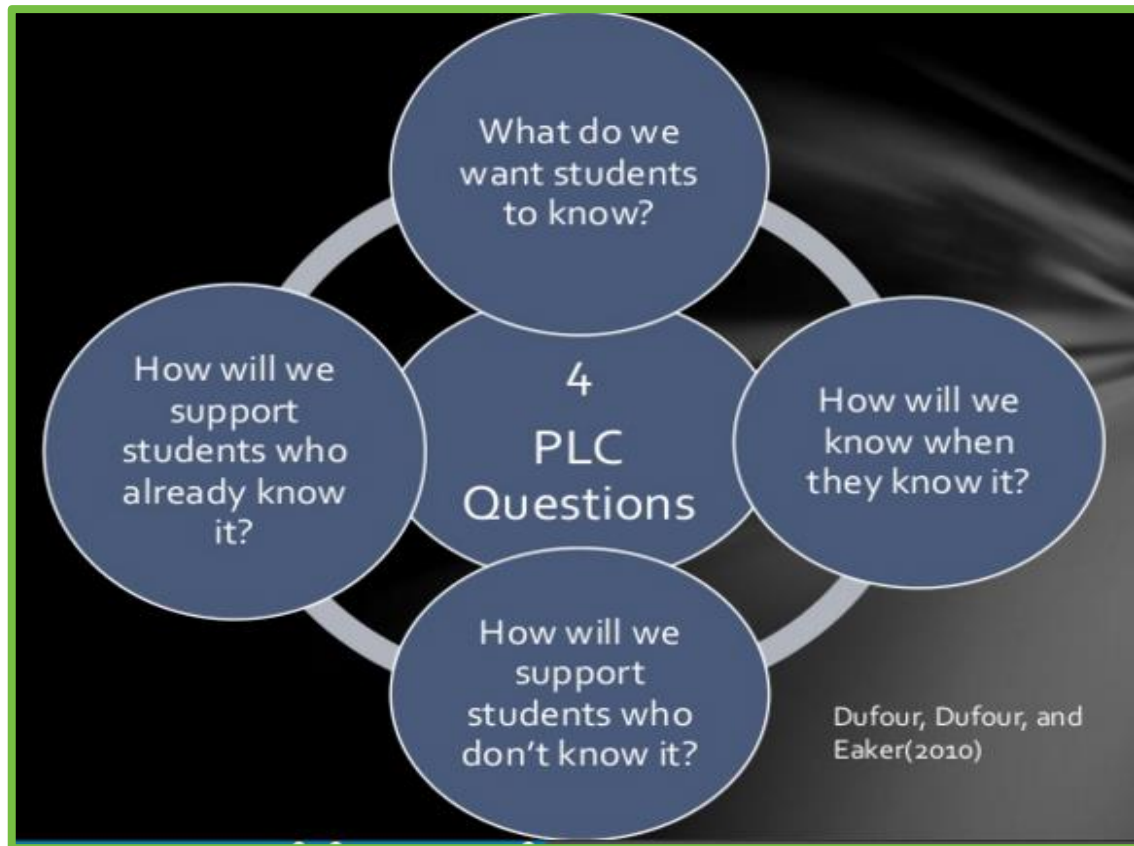

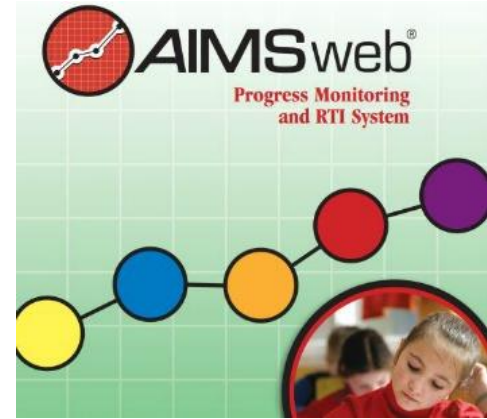

Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS)

- A framework that takes a proactive approach to coordinate behavioral and social supports.
- The goal is to empower students to display appropriate behaviors so they can be contributing, successful members of their communities.
- PBIS helps students learn the social and emotional skills that are necessary for academic achievement.
