WELCOME! Girls Southeast (GSE for girls) and Southeast Cincinnati Soccer Association (SCSA for boys) have been providing community soccer in the Southeast Cincinnati area for over 50 years. Our programs provide kids the opportunity to have fun, exercise and learn teamwork playing recreational soccer. There are no try-outs, and you don't need experience to play! Kids can play in the spring if they will turn 5 years old or older any time in 2026. Players are assigned to teams based on age and neighborhood areas. Younger players learn a simplified game on a smaller sized field.

DEVELOPMENT ACADEMY INCLUDED: Operated by our partner Cincinnati United Soccer Club (the largest and most successful competitive soccer club in the area), the Academy features age-appropriate training through individual skills, techniques and fun games led by their professional coaches on weekday evenings during the spring season. Girls born in 2019, 2020, and 2021 and boys born in 2018, 2019 and 2020 are automatically enrolled at no extra cost in our Development Academy.

LATE REGISTRATION POLICY: Late registrations will be accepted while space is available and late players can be placed on any team. Late fee may apply.

REFUND POLICY: After the due date, we will refund the league fee only if we are unable to place a player with a team.

VOLUNTEER: There are several opportunities for volunteers and our free clinics can teach you how to referee or coach, even if you've never played. You can sign up to volunteer on the same website as you use to register a player. Referees are a paid position and the pay varies by the age of the players. We need:

- Coaches (Free coach training is provided)
- Referees (Ages 12-adult, Referee classes held in summer)
- Field hands
- Back office jobs (assigning players, referees, fields, printing flyers, etc)
- New board members

COMING THIS FALL: SCSA is changing its cutoff dates so that boys who turn 4 before August 1 will be eligible to register as Dribblers for the fall season. We hope this results in age groups that match up with school years, so more boys will play with their classmates.

SCSA and GSE are community based volunteer organizations incorporated in the State of Ohio as non-profit organizations.
