#### **Superintendent Hook Introduces the Culture Blueprint**

We've shared a few details about FHSD's Culture Blueprint: Every Moment Matters as the school year has started. It's a document that three dozen of our staff members and administrators created together and the entire district staff was introduced to in August training. #### Turpin High School Ranks in Top 2% of Ohio

Out of more than 1,000 schools evaluated, Turpin High School is ranked number 14 of all high schools in the state of Ohio! US News and World Report recently released their 2023 ranking of public high schools which takes into account many different measures of school quality. In addition to the overall ranking of 14 in Ohio, Turpin ranked number 8 in Ohio for College Readiness. #### **Turpin Traffic**

Thank you to all for helping adjust to the traffic pattern for student dropoff and pickup. We are still tweaking some things for the afternoon, but the morning has been very successful in keeping traffic flowing and more importantly, students safe.

One important update: The service drive near the auditorium should not be used as an exit in the morning. This is our student drivers' morning entrance and two-way traffic is very dangerous in that spot.

#### September 13th - Pre-ACT and Practice ACT

- On Wednesday, September 13th all 9th and 10th grade students will be taking the Pre-ACT. The Pre-ACT is a shortened, non-college reported prep test for the actual ACT.
- All 11th grade students will take a full length practice ACT, sponsored by TorchPrep (ACT Prep) on the same date. This practice ACT is also non-college reported.
- Once testing has concluded students will be dismissed from school (approx 11:30-12:30). Lunch and study hall will be provided for any students staying at school until 2:40. District busing will operate on its normal schedule on September 13th. Students not leaving after their testing dismissal time will attend study hall in the cafeteria until 2:40.
- All 12th grade students may use this day for college and career preparations. Seniors are encouraged to visit colleges/universities or job shadow in an area of interest on this day.
- Teachers are available in the afternoon for office hours.

On October 24, 2023 Turpin High School will be administering the PSAT to any 11th grade student that would like to take this exam. The PSAT helps 11th grade students to prepare for the SAT and provides entry into the **National Merit Scholarship Competition**. Students in the 11th grade are not required to take the exam; however, if you would like for your student to take the PSAT you can register them at the link below or provide a check Kim Shriver in the Academic Office. All checks will need to be made to Forest Hills Local School District for \$18. The deadline for registration is this **Friday, September 29, 2023**. #### Immunization Due Date: Sept. 8, 2023

The deadline for students to have required vaccination documentation on file for school attendance in the state of Ohio is quickly approaching.

The Ohio Revised Code states no student may attend a school for more than fourteen (14) days without written evidence that immunizations have been completed in accordance with state of Ohio immunization requirements for school attendance (ORC 3313.67 and 3313.671).

The deadline to turn in proof of required vaccinations is Friday, September 8,2023.

Students without documentation of required vaccines or evidence of being in process, cannot be at school or participate in extracurricular activities beginning Friday, September 8, 2023 until they are in compliance.
