<u>Open House</u>

On Wednesday, August 23 from 6:30pm to 8:10pm, Turpin is hosting an Open House to allow you to meet each of your student's teachers. You will have the opportunity to follow an abbreviated version of your student's daily schedule; ten minutes per class. You will report to each of the classes on your student's schedule except for the flex time period. Teachers will share general information about the class content, expectations, policies, materials needed, etc.

Parking Lot Safety

We are asking for parents' help in making our parking lot safer in the morning and afternoon. Please help us in establishing a one-way loop for morning dropoff (see below). Do not turn down the parking aisles in the morning. <u>All student dropoffs should be in front of the athletic entrance, at the far end of the building</u>. This will allow busses to park in the lane closest to the school and parents to exit in the lane to the left of busses.

In the afternoon, parent pickup will be in the parking aisles closest to Bartels Rd. This allows parents to exit the parking lot prior to student drivers. Please do not turn around and exit the same way you entered.

Update on Lunch/Fee Payments

With more people opting to pay school fees and lunch balances with cash/checks this year, we've received some questions around that process. **All payments should be brought to your student's school office and lunch balance payments should be SEPARATE from school fees.** This is required because the money is deposited into different accounts. School lunch payments should be made out to the School Name + Food Service or Cafeteria. The cash/check will need to include the child's name (first and last) as well as their student ID number. If there are to be multiple students for one check they will need to indicate each student's name and student ID number with the amount for each student's account.
