Homecoming Dance

We are looking forward to our Homecoming Weekend tonight and tomorrow, and hope that all of our Spartans have a safe and enjoyable time! The Homecoming Football Game is tonight at 7:00pm vs. Loveland, and our Dance is tomorrow evening from 8:00pm to 11:00pm. At this time, dance ticket sales have ended and no more can be sold.

The dance is a large event and we ask for everyone's cooperation in keeping the event safe and fun. We will have law enforcement on site throughout the evening coordinating with administration throughout the evening.

Students are allowed to leave the dance prior to 11:00pm, but may not return after leaving. If you are providing transportation for your student, please have a plan for pickup time, which should occur along the sidewalk in front of the school. If your student is driving, Homecoming often has student drivers traveling to parts of town they may not be very familiar with. We encourage you to have them check in with you as they arrive and depart at various locations for pictures, dinner, dance, etc.

School Picture Retakes:

All school pictures and student IDs were passed out last week in your child's FLEX. If your child did not have their picture taken on the first day of school or need a picture retake Dingo Photography will be here on Wednesday, Oct. 4th from 9:00am-10:30am for retakes. Please have your child bring the original school picture order with them to picture retakes.

Last Call for PSAT 2023 (Juniors Only)

On October 24, 2023 Turpin High School will be administering the PSAT to any 11th grade student that would like to take this exam. The PSAT helps 11th grade students to prepare for the SAT and provides entry into the **National Merit Scholarship Competition**. Students in the 11th grade are not required to take the exam; however, if you would like for your student to take the PSAT you can register them at the link below or provide a check Kim Shriver in the Academic Office. All checks will need to be made to Forest Hills Local School District for \$18. The deadline for registration is **TODAY**, **September 29**, **2023**. Schedule Change on October 24, 2023 - PSAT

The PSAT is scheduled to be administered at THS on October 24th. This will require an altered schedule to accommodate the testing. Please see the plan for each grade level below.

- **9th Grade & 12th Grade-** This will be a day for students to complete assignments electronically at home. This means students **should not** report to school and will have assignments posted on their class Schoology Pages to complete for the day. There are no requirements for virtual meetings.
- **10th graders-** All students will take the PSAT/NMSQT on October 24th, 2023. Testing will begin promptly at 8 am; students should bring their school provided chromebooks (charged). The PSAT is 100% digital and requires students to use their school provided

chromebooks (no personal devices). Students will be dismissed from school at the completion of testing (approx. 11:30-12:00).

- 11th Grade- All Juniors taking the PSAT/NMSQT on October 24th will begin promptly at 8 am; students should bring their school provided chromebooks (charged). The PSAT is 100% digital and requires students to use their school provided chromebooks (no personal devices). Students will be dismissed from school at the completion of testing (approx. 11:30-12:00). 11th grade students **not** participating in the PSAT/NMSQT will have assignments to complete at home. This means students should not report to school and will have assignments posted on their class Schoology Pages to complete for the day.
- District busing will operate on its normal schedule on October 24th. Students not leaving at their testing dismissal time will attend study hall in the cafeteria until 2:40.
