# Afternoon Dismissal Reminder

Recently we experienced a concerning incident where a car attempted to pass a moving bus during dismissal, resulting in a near accident. To ensure the safety of our students and everyone involved we need your cooperation with afternoon dismissal. Never attempt to pass a moving bus once it's in motion. Please refrain from moving your vehicle when our buses are in motion rolling out of the parking lot. Doing so could pose potential risks and potentially lead to accidents. We recognize that everyone is eager to leave the parking lot at the end of the day but please be patient so we can get everyone out of the lot safely.
