Are there doctor notes lying around your house looking for a place to be filed, stuck in the crevices of the car hiding from detection, or folded up in the bottom of your student's backpack? *There is a solution!* Have your student bring them into the main office, email them to anitabryant@foresthills.edu or have the doctor's office fax us at 513.232.9047.

WHEN? Anytime, but sooner is better than later.

WHY? When a doctor note is received, your student's absence can be marked as "medically excused.". Without these doctor notes, some absences may be marked as "unexcused." Most importantly, these notes are vital for our records and help us provide support and accommodations as needed for your student.

New Construction Project to Shut Down Portion of Clough Pike

Beginning March 11, the Hamilton County Engineer's Office will begin a second landslide repair project on Clough Pike that is expected to continue through mid-May. This involves a FULL ROAD CLOSURE of Clough in between Five Mile Road and Wolfangel Road. FHSD is closely monitoring the work and it may be necessary to adjust some bus routes specifically impacted by the road closure. If you or your student travels near this project to get to school, please be aware of potential impacts to traffic along the detour route and in surrounding areas.
