Student Food Delivery Services:

We want to inform you of an important update regarding our practice related to food delivery services (DoorDash, GrubHub, etc.). In the interest of safety and security within Turpin HS, we have made the decision to discontinue the acceptance of food deliveries on our campus during school hours (8:00am-2:40pm). This decision was not taken lightly, but rather, it stems from our commitment to ensuring the safety of all of our students and staff. While we understand the convenience that food delivery services provide, there have been a growing number of instances that cause disruption to the school day and a potential safety concern within the building. We believe this change will help maintain a safe and orderly environment for everyone. Starting on Monday, Nov. 20th, we will no longer be accepting food delivery services during school hours. We encourage you to consi der alternative options for your child's meal needs such as packing lunches or utilizing our cafeteria.
