Quarter report cards are now posted on [Progressbook](#). Please note that quarter grades are not permanently recorded on a student transcript; only final semester grades are recorded. Semester grades are determined by formula: 45% 1st quarter numerical grade, 45% 2nd quarter, and 10% semester final exam. For courses without a final exam, the two quarter grades are numerically averaged.

PreACT Results

PreACT results from the September 2023 administration will be distributed to 9th and 10th grade students in FLEX time Monday. Each student will receive their individualized score report and their test booklet. As you review the scores please take into consideration that the PreACT is intended to provide a pre-assessment/baseline for students and that the test includes some academic content that may not have yet been introduced to 9th grade students.
