

2023-2024 SCHOOL PROFILE

Turpin High School is one of two college preparatory high schools in the Forest Hills School District, located in southwest Ohio approximately ten miles east of downtown Cincinnati. Forest Hills is comprised of Anderson Township and the Village of Newtown. The district has a population of approximately 47,000 and a median family income of \$102,000.

With an enrollment of approximately 1,100 students in grades 9–12, Turpin is known for its rigorous academic standards, high participation in outstanding athletics and arts programs, and for being a welcoming community guiding students to find their place and voice in the world. 10% of students receive special education services, 11% receive section 504 accommodations, and 14% are identified as economically disadvantaged. The student body is 88% White, 4% Hispanic, 3% Asian, 3% Multiracial, and 2% Black.


Academic Placement & Transcripts

Turpin High School does not rank students. There are two advanced course levels in the core subject areas to meet student needs and interests: Advanced Placement or Honors (Honors in areas where AP is not offered) and College Preparatory. Students are recommended for Honors and Advanced Placement courses by considering teacher recommendation, test results, and past academic record. However, all students may choose to enroll in upper-level courses.

All high school courses are included in both unweighted and weighted GPA. High school courses taken at the middle school are listed on the transcript but are not weighted for GPA.


