25-26 FHSD Half-Day Kindergarten Update:

In 25-26, FHSD will again offer three sections of half-day kindergarten (HDK), which will include two sections at Ayer Elementary (AM/PM) and one section at Mercer Elementary (AM-only). HDK students whose "home school" is Ayer/Summit will attend HDK in the AM at Ayer; students from Maddux/Wilson will attend HDK in the PM at Ayer; and finally those from Mercer/Sherwood will attend the PM section at Mercer. Lastly, all HDK students will then return to their "home school" in accordance with the District's attendance policy,
