Here's how it works: students can bring in coins as they enter school in the morning and drop the coins in the grade appropriate jar. Only quarters are positive and should be placed in their grade's jar (1 quarter = 25 points). All other coins and bills are negative points for the grade level they chose to put the money in (1 penny = -1 or 1 = -100 points). Students are encouraged to raise the coins to bring in and can then fill out a service slip explaining what they did to earn the donation. The grade level with the most service slips and the most points each day will be recognized.
